1. NEWS ABOUT EURO K.

K = 1: EURO 1, the first Congress on Operations Research jointly organized by the European O.R. Societies was held in Brussels on January 27-29th 1975.

Most of the classical topics of O.R. were treated during this Conference, but recent themes so as Fuzzy Sets and Multicriteria Analysis were also discussed.

105 papers were presented during 36 sessions. Some of them were devoted to theory (Mathematical Programming, Branch and Bound Methods, Queuing Theory, Game Theory...) but there were also important sessions devoted to practical applications (Decision Making in the public sector, Health Services, Production Control...).

More than 450 participants registered. Most of them came from Western Europe, but here were also some people from Eastern Europe, Africa, Australia, Canada, Israel and the United States.

K = 2: The EURO II Congress will probably be organized in Sweden in the Winter 1976/77.

2. NEWS FROM THE EURO ASSOCIATION.

EURO I was the first visible result of common activities of the European Operations Research Societies. In its framework an agreement was signed by eleven European Operations Research Societies establishing the European Association of the International Federation of Operations Research Societies, the EURO ASSOCIATION.

The Preamble of this agreement expressing the intention of its founders reads as follows:

«In the belief that the purpose of Operational Research is to improve the well-being of people by improving the relevance and effectiveness of the instutions and organisations which serve them; that it seeks to do so by means of the rational methods of science exercised by representatives of divers disciplines working together, each supporting the others; that

this co-operation which respects no boundaries between disciplines should respect no boundaries between peoples; and that the Operational Research Societies of Europe should more closely co-operate one with another to further the theory and practice of Operational Research; we the authorised representatives of our several societies make this Agreement to establish the European Association of the International Federation of Operations Research Societies».

The next meeting of this association will be held in Amsterdam on May 8th.
