NEWS ABOUT EURO K AND ABOUT A EURO-TIMS MEETING

K = 1. The proceedings of the first European Congres on Operational Resarch, EURO I, which was held in Brussels on January 27-29, 1975 are still available. These proceedings include the abstracts of all papers and the addresses of the authors, as well as the full texts of the opening and closing papers. It is published by the North Holland Publishing Company. The price is very low but a limited number of copies are available. People interested in these proceedings are requested to fill in the order form on page 4 of the present bulletin.

K = 2. The Second European Congress on Operational Research, EURO II, will be held in Stockholm on November 29 - December 1, 1976. There will be plenary sessions and a paper fair. The deadline to introduce an abstract was February 1, 1976. About 150 abstracts were submitted to Professor Dr. M. ROUBENS, Chairman of the programme committee, so that we may expect that EURO II will again be a success.

The programme committee selected the papers on the basis of these abstracts on February 28 and the authors were notified on March 15. The papers will be refereed in September and proceedings of selected papers will be printed. Copies of the presented papers will be distributed to the participants.

2. NEWS ABOUT THE EURO ASSOCIATION

The first meeting of the Council of the EURO association was held on Friday June 18, 1976 in Brussels.

The definitive statutes and by-laws of EURO were ratified in toto by the OR Societies of: BELGIUM, DENMARK, FINLAND, FRANCE, GERMANY, GREECE, IRELAND, ITALY, THE NETHERLANDS, SPAIN, SWITZERLAND and the UNITED KINGDOM. These societies are therefore members of the Association. The Swedish Society asked to make the interpretation of article III about the commitment of a member society clear. This article was amended with very restricted commitment. It was hoped that the Swedish Society would find it easier to accept. It was unanimously agreed that TURKEY be admitted as an associate member. The applications of ALGERIA and AUSTRIA were also discussed but no decision was taken because of some local particular situation.

The election of officers of the association took place. The following nominations were made:

President: Professor Dr. H.J. ZIMMERMANN Vice-President: Professor Dr. G. KREWERAS

Secretary: Professor Dr. R. EDDISON Treasurer: Professor Dr. J.P. BRANS.

It was unanimously agreed that these four would form the executive committee.

The EJOR, European Journal, made good progress and the first issue dated January 1977, will in fact be published before the EURO II Conference. (see also point 5: Publications).

The TIMS (Technical Institute of Management Science) was interested in having its XIII International meeting co-sponsered by EURO. This meeting will take place in Athens (GREECE) on July 25-27, 1977. It was decided that if the Greek society is in favour of participation EURO should co-sponsor this conference. In the meantime the Greek society accepted.
